



# COOKIES POLICY

This "Cookies" Policy applies to the services provided by the company **AMP TRAVEL LTD** Company Number 13500131 established at 138, Chapel Street - Salford - UK - M3 6DE, hereinafter referred to as **AMP TRAVELS**, through the websites [www.amplitur.com](http://www.amplitur.com) and [www.amp-travels.com](http://www.amp-travels.com).

## 1. NAVIGATION DATA (COOKIES)

The **AMP TRAVELS system** occasionally uses "cookie" techniques, which allow it to analyze statistics and information about the user's navigation. "Cookies" are small amounts of information that are stored by the user's browser so that the server remembers certain information that later and only the server that implemented it will be able to read. For example, data can be provided about the device used by the user and its location and access time. This collection of information seeks to improve navigation, for the user's comfort, by allowing us to present personalized services, according to their preferences.

"Cookies" do not allow them to extract any information from the user's hard drive, nor to steal any type of personal information. The only way in which the user's private information forms part of the browsing data is for the user to personally give this information to the server.

The "cookies" that make it possible to identify a person are considered personal data. Therefore, the same rules described above apply to "cookies".

These navigation data may also be shared with any partners of the **AMP TRAVELS system**, seeking to improve the products and services offered to the user.

The user may object to the registration of "cookies" by the **AMP TRAVELS system**, simply deactivating this option in their own browser or device. On the other hand, disabling this registry may affect the availability of some tools and services of the **AMP TRAVELS system**.

## 2. AMP TRAVELS SYSTEM COOKIES

The "cookies" of the **AMP TRAVELS system** are those cookies that are sent to the computer or device of the user and administrator exclusively by the website, for its better functioning.

The information collected is used to improve the quality of the **AMP TRAVELS system** and its content and user experience. This information allows you to recognize the user as a recurring visitor to the website and adapt the content to offer content tailored to your preference.

## 3. THIRD PARTY COOKIES

Third-party "cookies" are cookies used and managed by other websites or applications that provide the **AMP TRAVELS system** with services requested by it to improve the content offered and the user experience. The main purposes of using third-party cookies are to obtain access statistics and analyze the user's browsing information, that is, how the user interacts with the application.

The entities in charge of collecting cookies may transfer this information to third parties.

## 4. SOCIAL MEDIA COOKIES

The **AMP TRAVELS system** uses social media plugins, which allow you to access them from the website. In this way, cookies from social networks can be stored in the user's browser. The holders of social networks have their own privacy policy and data protection and cookies, and they are, in each case, responsible for the personal data collected and their privacy practices. The user must research with social networks how their personal data are treated.
